## What Needed to Change?

- Better adherence to the REC Foundation Organizational Policy
  - o organizational types defined in the wizard
  - criteria checkboxes to help determine organizational type
  - o organizational policy acknowledgement
  - acknowledgement of our right to reclassify an organization and/or request additional verification
- Improved Awareness of other REC Foundation and VEX Policies and Documents
  - acknowledgements of the Code of Conduct and Student Centered policies, Game Manual, team contact definitions, and the Commitment to Coach Excellence





# Requirements

## What Needed to Change?

- New School-Based Organization Initiatives required more reliable/accurate data and Protections of School-based Organizations
  - upload of proof-of-organization documentation for school-based organizations (public, private, charter, university)
  - may bypass to finish registration, but must upload proof (and receive RSM approval) before being able to register for first event
- Improved Understanding of Our Community Makeup
  - upload of proof-of-organization documentation for community / non-profit organizations


## What Needed to Change?

- Youth Protection Improvements
  - Verification that all team contacts are adults (18 years+)
  - Event day emergency phone numbers required
  - No shared email addresses that could be students



#### CONFLICTING ORGANIZATION POPUP






